Our experienced and highly skilled team of board-certified adolescent medicine specialists care for patients 12-21 years of age with complex medical, social, and multi-disciplinary needs unique to this age group while understanding and providing for best care according to individual developmental needs and confidentiality of all patients.

#### WHAT WE TREAT

#### **Eating Disorders**

- Assessment and management of Bulimia Nervosa, Anorexia Nervosa, Avoidant Restrictive Food Intake Disorder, and other eating disorders
- We provide a multidisciplinary approach to care including specialists from the field of mental health, social work, and nutrition science in addition to our physician specialists.

#### **Reproductive Health**

- Management and implementation of comprehensive contraception
- Confidential screening, diagnosis and management of sexually transmitted infections and sequelae for both females and males
- Adolescent gynecological services including abnormal uterine bleeding, PCOS, painful menses, heavy menses, irregular or absent menses
